Background:

The heavy rainfall and flooding that hit Serbia in mid May 2014, severely affected Belgrade municipalities (Obrenovac, Lazarevac) and left huge consequences in the Districts of Kolubara, Macva and Morava. Almost 32,000 people were evacuated from their homes, 24,000 from Obrenovac only. Thirty-three people lost their lives.

The Government reports that more than 2,260 buildings were flooded, over 1,800 damaged, above 30,000 households are left without electricity. Thirty bridges were demolished and 50 damaged on categorized roads, while there are 200 bridges that were affected on municipal or uncategorized roads. Other reports describe damage on 3,700 kilometres of roads, mainly in western and central parts of the country.

Project Purpose: Normalising livelihood of citizens affected by floods through restoration of infrastructure

Result Areas:

Result 1: Reconstruction and repair of public buildings in selected municipalities (including comprehensive assessment of technical and financial needs in regards repair, reconstruction or construction works on public buildings; preparation of a database summarizing the assessment results; preparation of planning and technical documentation for the reconstruction of the public buildings; procurement of building material, equipment and supplies; conducting the works).

Result 2: Repair or reconstruction of damaged private housing (including delivery of building material packages; purchase of village houses or supply and instalment of prefabricated houses for persons affected by the floods; supervision and monitoring), respecting human rights standards and non-discrimination principle of good governance

The United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) intends to pre-qualify suppliers and/or firms for Reconstruction and repair of public buildings and damaged private houses within Serbia Emergency Flood Recovery Programme

It is expected that the related Invitation to Bid/Request for Proposal will be issued in July/August 2014.
